- "Another Day in Paradise" mural, Las Vegas, NV (June 2024; 375 sq ft) This mural will be installed at Paradise Pointe Skate Park and is a skateboarding theme embodying the daring, adrenaline, free-spirit nature that embodies skate culture. Color, movement, and overall composition provide a backdrop which will be appreciated and enjoyed by skaters and fans of skateboard culture. My design will feature skaters doing a multitude of tricks using colors that are vibrant and engaging. Skaters will illustrate the word "Paradise", where the angles/curves of the letters are ramps, rails, and half pipes. The background landscape will feature pops of plant life, open colorful skies, and the radiance of the sun.
- "Community Heroes" mural, Palm Desert, CA (May 2024; dimensions 160 ft x 6ft)
 Mural honors the public works department of Palm Desert and their heroic efforts serving
 the community during hurricane Hillary. Funded by the City of Palm Desert, this
 community mural project will be led under my direction and supervision to allow
 community volunteers to assist in the installation of this mural.
- "Young Legends" mural, Downtown Pittsfield, Inc, Pittsfield, MA (September 2023;
 450 sq ft) Mural pays tribute to Pittsfield natives who achieved success and represent the city as an inspiration to the youth and community. This mural was funded by Downtown Pittsfield Inc. and created based off of photos and stories provided by key stakeholders to create a dynamic and vibrant design.
- "Generations" mural, Hillsborough Community College Ybor City Campus, Tampa, FL (July 2023; 2000+ sq ft) Mural highlights the college's academic offerings and the rich & diverse history of the Ybor City community. This 3-story immersive mural showcases the educational programs including firefighting program, law enforcement academy, automotive technology program, welding, and dance. These images are weaved together against the backdrop of Ybor which was once the cigar capital of the world in the early 1900's as a result of the Cuban, Spanish, and Italian immigrants, notably Vicente Martinez Ybor and Jose Marti (featured in the mural), who founded the city and brought economic prosperity. Red brick architecture, lampposts, cigars, trolleys, flamenco dancers of the era combined with the colors of the Ybor City flag create a vibrant backdrop for students and visitors to the campus.
- "EXPLORE" mural, Downtown Zephyrhills, FL (August 2022; 500 sq ft) Mural
 encourages the growing community to explore its past, present, and future via landmarks
 and attractions. Mainstreet Zephyrhills Inc. in partnership with the City of Zephyrhills, FL

commissioned me to design and install this mural to represent Zephyrhills which is known as a destination for skydiving (aka "skydive city"). The WWII History Museum, Train Depot Station, golf, Sarah Vande Berg Tennis Center, skate park, and water park, are also featured in this family-friendly mural.
